Prayer of Great Thanksgiving (including the Prayers of the People)

*Pastor: Father of mercy and God of all comfort,

*In this present time, we on earth  
have communion with you in heaven.  
But in the time to come we shall be raised to that  
endless joy prepared for us before the foundation of  
the world was laid.*

*We acknowledge that we have received these  
inestimable gifts by your free mercy and grace,  
through your only Son, Jesus Christ.  
Moved by your Holy Spirit, we, your congregation, give you  
all thanks, praise, and glory for ever and ever.*

*Amen.*

Breaking of Bread

*The Lord Jesus, on the night of his arrest, took bread, and after giving thanks to God, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." [as the minister lifts or pours the cup] In the same way he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me." Every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the saving death of the risen Lord until he comes.*
